Destination Horse Show is Back

Cedar Run's first Equine Canada Gold Sanctioned show - the Hunter Jumper Classic - was a whirlwind week of great competition and a little fun too! More than 300 horses and hundreds of competitors, with their coaches, grooms and families, came from all over Ontario and surrounding areas to compete for \$40,000 in prize money.

Cedar Run is proud to bring the 'destination horse show' back to the Blue Mountains area. This is an important event for the region from a tourism and economic impact standpoint, and we intend to work closely with the Town, County, tourism organizations and local businesses and associations to maximize the positive impact this event can and will have on the local economy.

This show will be even better in 2012, because it will be two weeks long. Confirmed dates are July 4-8 and 11-15. Stay tuned for more details in the coming months.



Riding the Rodeo Wave

Who says you can't make a dude out of a city slicker? Judging by the more than 3,000 spectators who enjoyed the Cedar Run Rodeo Weekend this past summer, just about everyone enjoys a good old dose of country! This year, Cedar Run partnered with Rawhide Rodeo Company to host a professional weekend of live bull riding, bronc riding and performances by the Canadian Cowgirls,

highlighted by live entertainment from local bands and a busy vendor area. A special Kid's Hour featured a calf scramble, mutton busting and face painting, while troops from the local Land Force Training Centre in Meaford were also on-site to conduct live demonstrations and give vehicle rides. A portion of proceeds in the amount of \$6,000 was donated to Camp Maple Leaf, a charitable organization providing camps for underprivileged children and a place for military families to have a getaway after a recent deployment.

Horse Trials Strike a Spectator Chord

Cedar Run Horse Trials were a hit in 2011, experiencing their strongest attendance to date, and plans are already under way for two more events next year. Horse trials bring together three riding disciplines - cross-country, stadium jumping and dressage - in one action-packed day of competition. Nearly every corner of the park is put to use with something for spectators to see in every ring and even out on the trail system. Stay tuned for more details about construction of an upper-level course as Cedar Run continues to advance its cross country course. All eyes are focused on the opportunity to host the Ontario Championships in 2013.
