15. Double Clear – 1 Jump-Off – 0.8m (2'9")

* Can **enter** more than once in all classes except the Jumper Medal

Div. C - under 12 as of January 1, 2010

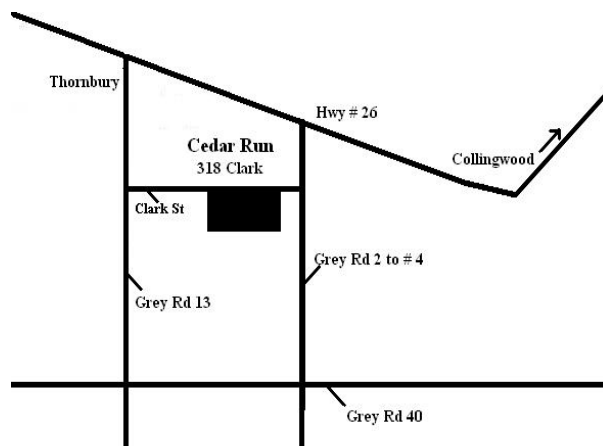
Div. B - passed 12th birthday but under 15 as of January 1, 2010
